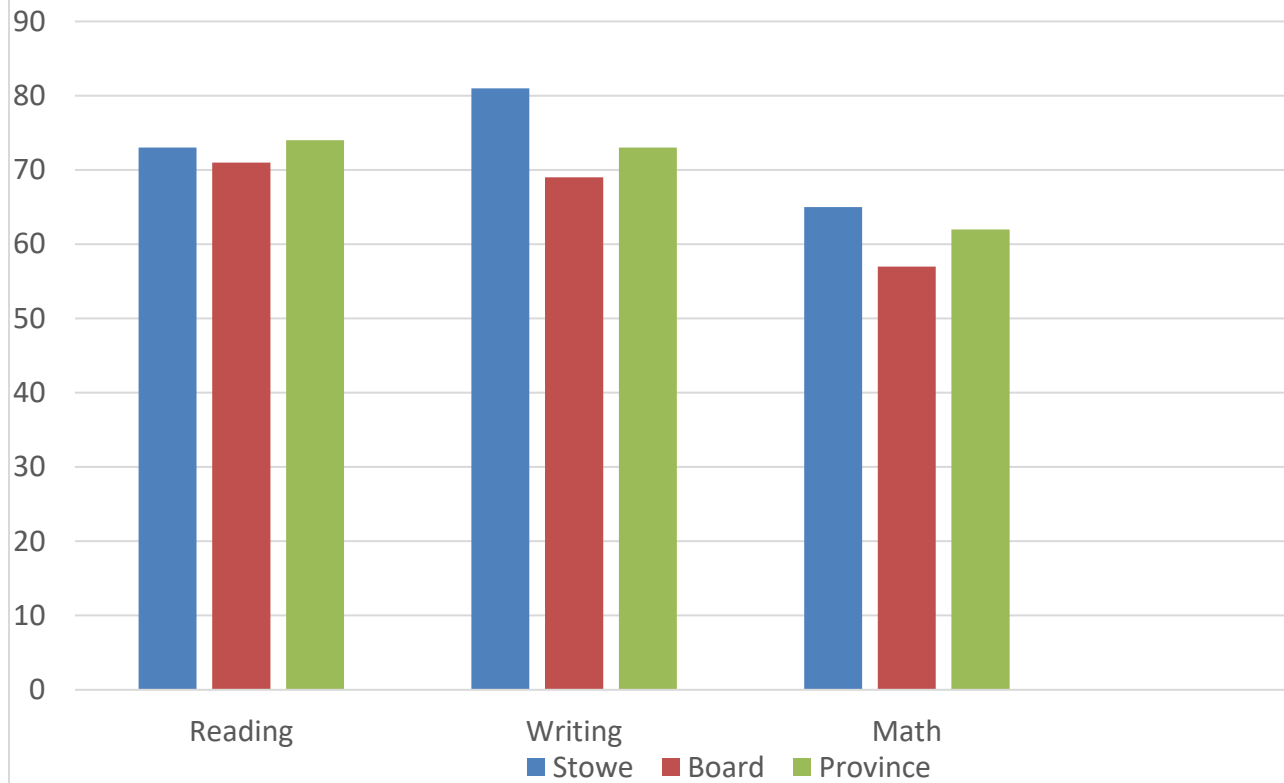
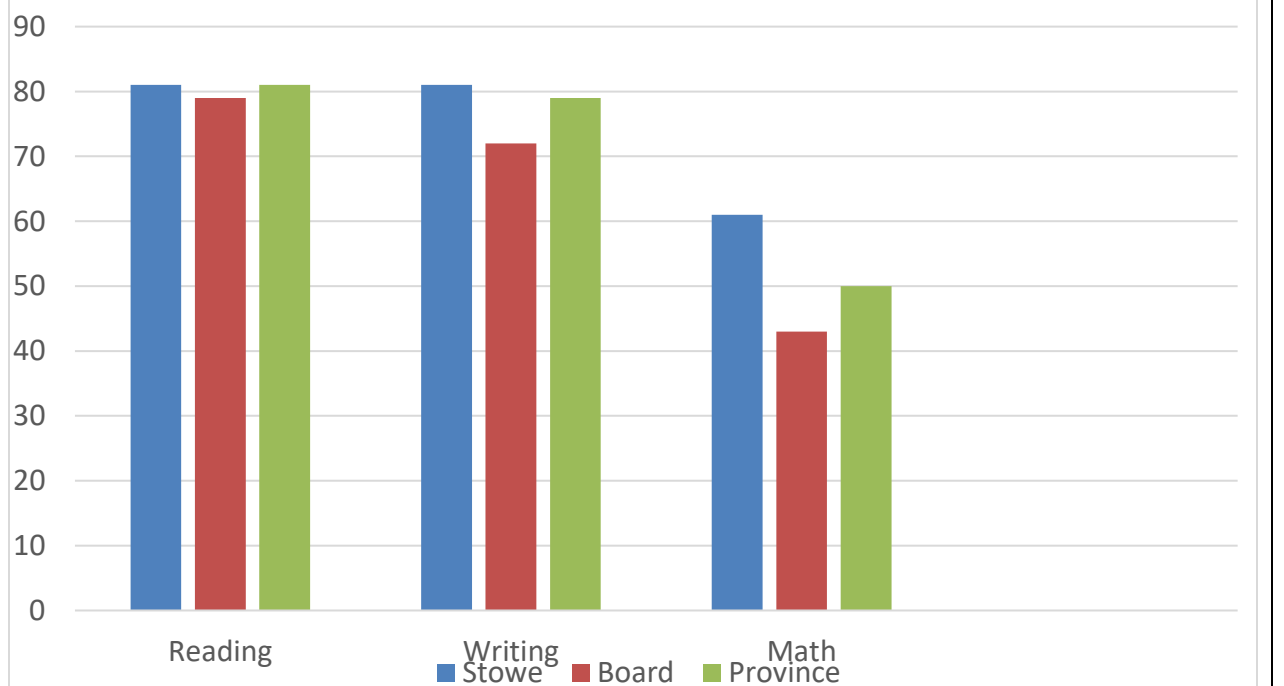

EQAO results

- Reading tends to be around the provincial level for both grades
- Writing is slightly above Province and Board
- Although math is lower, still higher than Province and Board

- Gr. 3's 23% special needs – almost 2x previous year

- Gr. 6's quite a few students who left early, went on vacation had to complete the test in one sitting

PA Day September

- Reviewed EQAO data & selected our mathematical focus from the Big 4 (algebraic reasoning K-8)
- We have already started working with selected marker students to improve their skills.
- Teachers involved in Math PD related to Scope & Sequence (1 in primary, 4 Jr / Intermediate and 1 SERT)

November PA – will continue to focus on professional development around math content learning and some co-planning and wellness goal
