Change to April PA Day

The Board has approved a change to the 2023-2024 School Year Calendar, reflecting that the scheduled April 26, 2024 Professional Activity Day has been moved to April 8, 2024.

A total solar eclipse will be affecting all regions of the Board on April 8, 2024, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m., causing diminished levels of daylight as it progresses. The peak of the eclipse will occur during dismissal time across the school board, increasing student safety concerns for safe travel and potentially damaging eye exposure to the sun at that time. Resources to support learning and student safety on that day will be shared throughout the school board community.

Dental screenings are done every year in all elementary schools. Here is some helpful information about the program.

Why screen?

- ³⁰ Teeth are important! We assist eligible children and youth to access FREE dental treatment programs
- Dental screening is mandated by the Ontario Public Health Standards

Who will be screened?

- All students in JK, SK, Grade 2, 4, 6, 7, and special education classes
- Any student previously identified as having an urgent need
- Any additional student by parent/guardian request
- Children identified with an urgent need may have additional screenings throughout the year

What happens at the screening?

- Dental screening is a visual assessment. They do not replace your child's regular dental examination
- Sterilized mouth mirrors are used for each student
- Screening results will be sent home with your child

Where does screening occur?

- Dental screenings are done at your child's school
- Screenings can also be scheduled from 8:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. at our dental clinic located at 200 John Street West, Unit E8, Oshawa ON L1J 2B4

If you wish to have your child excluded from the dental screening or if your child is not in one of the grades listed and you would like them to participate, please contact the Oral Health Division at 905-723-1365 or 1-866-853-1326 ext. 4570 or email at <u>dentalscreening@durham.ca</u>

PLEASE NOTE: Exclusion and inclusion requests will not be carried over to the next school year.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding your child's oral health, you can call our dental clinic. Our community dental health programs are designed to support and encourage your efforts to provide the best dental health for your children.
